RESOLUTION OF THE BECLABITO CHAPTER

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE NAVAJO NATION PRESIDENT'S OFFICE, EXECUTIVE DIVISIONS. LEGISLATIVE COUNCILS TO APPROVE THE NAVAJO NATION FISCAL RECOVERY FUND (NNRFR/ARPA) \$8,802,340 PER DELEGATE REGION FUND FOR BECLABITO CHAPTER'S SEPTIC CLEANING FOR RESIDENTS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$12,500.00 (TWELVE HUNDRED FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS)

WHEREAS:

- Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 3 (A), the Beclabito Chapter is a duly recognized Certified Chapter of the Navajo Nation Government, as listed at 11 N.N.C., part 1, section 10; and
- 2. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C. Section 1 (B), the Beclabito Chapter is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community and to make appropriate correction when necessary and make recommendations to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate actions; and
- 3. The Beclabito Chapter is aware of the allocation of \$8,402,340 per Council Delegate Region and the allocation amount of \$1,257,477 for Beclabito Chapter.
- 4. The Beclabito Chapter has identified needs with a price tag of \$12,500.00 for Septic Clean outs for residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT BE RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Beclabito Chapter approves and recommends the \$12,500 of the Delegate Region Area Allocation for Septic Cleanouts for residents.
