APPROVING THE APPENDIX A, THE NAVAJO NATION FISCAL RECOVERY FUNDS REQUEST FORM AND EXPENDITURE PLAN FOR MEXICAN WATER CHAPTER'S PURCHASE OF A NEW BACKHOE FOR EMERGENCY BURIAL ASSISTANCE FOR COVID-19 RELATED DEATHS, TO UNLOAD AND LOAD PPE'S, WATER, WOOD, COAL, AND FOOD FROM SEMI AND CARGO TRUCKS TO MITIGATE THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC.

WHEREAS,

- 1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 102 (B); which permits Mexican Water Chapter to exercise local governance authorities contained within 26 N.N.C. Section 103, with the exception of land administration authority pursuant to 26 N.N.C. Section (D) (1); and
- Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 3 (A) the Mexican Water Chapter is a recognized certified Chapter of the Navajo Nation government, as listed at 11 N.N.C. part 1, section 10; and
- 3. Pursuant to CAP-34-98, the Navajo Nation Council adopted the Navajo Nation Local Governance Act (LGA); and
- 4. The Mexican Water Chapter is requesting funding from the ARPA funding pool in the amount of \$206,055.38 for
- 5. The Mexican Water Chapter will not use the backhoe to grade road for residents; and
- The Mexican Water Chapter will advertise through the Navajo Times newspaper for an invitation for bid to potential vendors operating on and off the Navajo Nation, announcing a Competitive Sealed Bidding.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT;

- The Mexican Water Chapter hereby approves Appendix A, the Navajo Nation Fiscal Recovery Funds Request Form and Expenditure Plan for Mexican Water Chapter's purchase of a new backhoe for emergency burial assistance for covid-19 related deaths, to unload and load PPE's, water, wood, coals and food from semi and cargo trucks to mititate the covid-19 pandemic; and
- 2. The Mexican Water Chapter Administration will be responsible for the operation and maintenance cost of the backhoe.
- The Mexican Water Chapter Administration shall initiate the procurement of backhoe in Fiscal Year 2023, and the estimated date of completion of the project will be before December 31, 2026.
