TNPCH-05-15-2023-R-74 SUPPORTING AND APPROVING THE APPENDIX A, THE NAVAJO NATION FISCAL RECOVERY FUNDS REOUEST FORM AND EXPENDITURE PI FOR TEEC NOS POS CHAPTER TO PURCHASE A NEW BACKHOE IN BURIAL AMOUNT OF \$204.163.57 FOR EMERGENCY COVID-19 RELATED DEATHS, TO UNLOAD AND LOAD COAL, AND FOOD FROM SEMI AND CARGO TRUCKS COVID-19 PANDEMIC.

WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 3 (A) the Teec Nos Pos Chapter is a duly recognized certified chapter of the Navajo Nation Government, as listed at 11 N.N.C., part 1, section 10 and
- 2. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 1 (B) Teec Nos Pos Chapter is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community and to make appropriate correction when necessary and make recommendation to the Navajo Nation and other Local agencies for appropriate
- 3. The Teec Nos Pos Chapter is requesting funding from the ARPA funding in the amount of \$204,163.57 to purchase a new backhoe; the backhoe will be used for Covid-19 related deaths for its Chapter membership and to unload load and load PPE's, Water, Food, Coal and Heavy Equipment; and
- 4. The backhoe is to serve Utah and Arizona residents of Teec Nos Pos Chapter to address COVID-19 death-related, health and safety issues to improve the standard of living to all residents, with an emphasis on the mitigating the spread of COVID-19 of the community; and
- 5. The Teec Nos Pos Chapter affirms the Chapter will only use awarded Fiscal Recovery Funds and implement this FRF Expenditure Plan in compliance with the ARPA, ARPA Regulations, and with all applicable federal and Navajo Nation laws, regulations and policies.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Teec Nos Pos Chapter hereby supports and approve the Appendix A, the Navajo Nation Fiscal Recovery Funds request form and Expenditure Pan for Teec Nos Pos Chapter to purchase a new backhoe in the amount of \$204,163.57 for emergency burial assistance for COVID-19 related deaths, to unload and load PPE's, Water, Wood, Coal, and Food from semi and cargo trucks to mitigate COVID-19 Pandemic..
