1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 3 (A) the Teec Nos Pos Chapter is a duly recognized certified chapter of the Navajo Nation Government, as listed at 11 N.N.C., part 1, section 10 and 2. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 1 (B) Teec Nos Pos Chapter is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community and to make appropriate correction when necessary and make recommendation to the Navajo Nation and other Local agencies for appropriate

actions; and

3. The Teec Nos Pos Chapter is requesting funding from the ARPA funding in the amount of \$1,267,200,00 for a 3 Bay 50' X 80"; 4000 square feet warehouse to store PPE's, Water, Food, Coal and Heavy Equipment; and

4. The project purpose is to serve Utah and Arizona residents of Teec Nos Pos Chapter to address health and safety issues to improve the standard of living to all residents, with an emphasis on the mitigating the spread of COVID-19 of the community; and

5. The Teec Nos Pos Chapter affirms the Chapter will only use awarded Fiscal Recovery Funds and implement this FRF Expenditure Plan in compliance with the ARPA, ARPA Regulations, and with all applicable federal and Navajo Nation laws, regulations and policies.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1.
