

WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 3 (A) the Jeddito Chapter is a duly recognized certified chapter of the Navajo Nation Government, as listed at 11 N.N.C. part 1, section 10, and
- 2. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 1 (8) Jeddito Chapter is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community and to make appropriate corrections when necessary and make recommendation to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate actions, and
- 3. The Jeddito Chapter recognizes that the financing of public project have become a major concern on the Navajo Nation and Nationally, therefore the ARPA fundings of 1.7 million will be used according to some of the needs of our constitutes; and
- 4. In times of scarce resources, it is necessary to find new financing mechanisms and maximize the use of existing resources; and
- 5. During the Pandemic times, many of our Navajo people suffered emotionally, spiritually, and physically; and
- 6. This project planning process contributes to leaving a multitude of resource in collaboration with local, regional, and national government and foundation and private entities.
