HOUSEWIRING, POWER AND ELECTRIC LINES, SOLAR SYSTEMS, HOUSING AND OTHER PROECTS NOT LIMITED TO ALL PROPOSED CHAPTER PRIHECTS RELATED TO COVID 19 PANDEMIC.

WHEREAS:

- Huerfano Chapter Certified as a local governmental unit of the Navajo Nation authorized by 2 NTC section 4001 and 4028 (a) to review and promote matters that affect the local community and to make appropriate recommendations to the Navajo Nation, Federal, State, County and local agencies for consideration and approval; and
- 2. Huerfano Chapter is recognized and certified chapter authorized under Navajo Nation Code Title 26 Local Governance Act of 1998p and
- 3. By Resolution CAP 34 98, the Navajo Nation Council approved the "local Governance Act" where the Navajo Nation delegated government authority to the Chapter of the Navajo to address matter of local concern with Navajo Law custom and tradition; and
- 4. Huerfano Chapter will submit ARPA "Appendix A" application to the FRF office with all required documents.
