House wiring/Upgrade- having Homesite or Residential Lease. Total of thirty (30) families living in the Southern or Northern area of Huerfano Chapter will be getting their homes wired for electricity, meter poles, or upgrade. Contractor will install all the wires, connections, outlets, switches, fuses, circuit breakers and ALL other required materials needed for electric service panels in accordance with the local building or electrical code (NEC) National Electrical Code. Some of the homes will be re-certified for connections. Without electricity in remote areas families have no communication for updated COVID safety guidelines.

Thirty (30) community families of Huerfano Chapters will finally get their homes connected with electricity so they can have electric system in their homes for refrigerator, HVAC unit, television, computer, microwave, and many more appliances. 3. By Resolution CAP 34 98, the Navajo Nation Council approved the "local Governance Act" where the Navajo Nation delegated government authority to the Chapter of the Navajo to address matter of local concern with Navajo Law custom and tradition; and

4. Huerfano Chapter will submit ARPA "Appendix A" application to the FRF office with all required documents.
