RESOLUTION OF NAGEEZI CHAPTER EASTERN AGENCY, DISTRICT 19 RESOLUTION # NC 23-040

APPROVING THE PROPOSED BUDGET OF \$50,000 FOR A COMMUNITY CEMETERY IN WHICH THE APPROPRIATION IS THROUGH THE \$8.8 MILLION COUNCIL DELEGATE REGIONAL PROJECTS.

WHEREAS:

Pursuant to 26 N.N.C. 1(B), the Nageezi Chapter is delegated to the governmental authority to make decision over local matters consistent with Navajo Law, Custom and Tradition and under 11 N.N.C. Part 10 also delegated authority to make local decisions in the best interest and welfare of the community members; and,

Nageezi Chapter with the population of 2500 to 3000 residents, registered and non-registered, is made up of (09) sub-communities including and not limited to Nageezi, Lybrook, Twin Pines, Blanco, Kimbeto, Chaco Canyon, Escavada, Betoni Wash, Kinnadiz and Dzilth-na-o-dith-hle, being one of the largest land based Navajo Chapter in Eastern Navajo Agency of the Navajo Nation; and,

Nageezi Chapter experienced a sad tragic turn for many community members who loss their lives, since 2020, in the COVID 19 pandemic which left many families to care for children who loss both set of parents and many others.

Nageezi Chapter community has been utilizing four (4) Christian Mission cemeteries in Lybrook, Escrito LDS, and Brethern In Christ Mission cemeteries as resources. The Chapter have been notified that by these missions that they will start charging families for any grave request or even close the cemetery due to lack of land.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT Nageezi Chapter approves the proposed budget of \$50,000 for a community cemetery to develop a cemetery on tribal trust land from Regional Council Delegate Projects.

Nageezi Chapter ("Chapter") affirms that the Chapter will only use awarded Fiscal Recovery Funds and implement this FRF Expenditure Plan in compliance with the ARPA, ARPA Regulations, and with all applicable federal and Navajo Nation laws, regulations, and Policies.
