APPROVING THE PROPOSED BUDGET OF \$200,292.00 FOR AND TOWARDS THE CHIPSEAL OF COUNTY ROAD 7900 THROUGH THE \$8.8 MILLION COUNCIL DELEGATE REGIONAL PROJECTS.

WHEREAS:

Pursuant to 26 N.N.C. 1(B), the Nageezi Chapter is delegated to the governmental authority to make decision over local matters consistent with Navajo Law, Custom and Tradition and under 11 N.N.C. Part 10 also delegated authority to make local decisions in the best interest and welfare of the community members; and,

Nageezi Chapter with the population of 2500 to 3000 residents, registered and non-registered, is made up of (09) sub-communities including and not limited to Nageezi, Lybrook, Twin Pines, Blanco, Kimbeto, Chaco Canyon, Escavada, Betoni Wash, Kinnadiz and Dzilth-na-o-dith-hle, being one of the largest land based Navajo Chapter in Eastern Navajo Agency of the Navajo Nation; and,

Nageezi Chapter continues dealing with pandemic of COVID 19 and requesting practice of COVID 19 illness, asking families to stay in place at their residence as much as possible.

Nageezi Chapter has families who are living without infrastructure utilities and passable road, making it unhealthy and unsafe in the pandemic era. Families need to get to medical facilities and emergency vehicles need to get to these families when needed. All weather road are a must in these unimproved areas.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT Nageezi Chapter approves the proposed budget of \$200,292.00 for and towards the chlpseal construction of County Road 7900 creating an all weather road for medical access and families to get daily necessities from Regional Council Delegate Projects.

Nageezi Chapter ("Chapter") affirms that the Chapter will only use awarded Fiscal Recovery Funds and implement this FRF Expenditure Plan in compliance with the ARPA, ARPA Regulations, and with all applicable federal and Navajo Nations laws, regulations and policies.
