



APPROVING THE REQUEST TO UTILIZE THE DELEGATE EDMUND YAZZIE REGIONAL EXPENDITURE PLAN FUNDS TO UPGRADE THE IYANBITO CHAPTER HOUSE AND IYANBITO SENIOR CENTER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$200,000.00.

WHEREAS:

1. Pursuant to Navajo Tribal Council Resolution W-30-55, and reaffirmed by Resolution CMY-23-79, the Council certifies and authorizes the Iyanbito Chapter as a Navajo Chapter; and
2. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 1, (B)(1)(2) and Section 103, the Iyanbito Chapter is recognized as a local government entity and delegated certain authorities and responsibilities with respect to local matters consistent with Navajo Nation laws; and
3. The Iyanbito Chapter, as part of Honorable Edmund Yazzie's Region, was allocated funds from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Delegate Regional Expenditure Plan to provide services to the community of Iyanbito Chapter; and
4. The Iyanbito Chapter is submitting a funding proposal in the amount of \$200,000.00 to plan, design, construct, and implement the Iyanbito Chapter's Upgrade Iyanbito Chapter House and Iyanbito Senior Center Project in accordance with Exhibit A; and
5. The Iyanbito Chapter will work with all stakeholders to plan, design, construct, and implement the Iyanbito Chapter's Upgrade Iyanbito Chapter House and Iyanbito Senior Center Project for the benefit of the community.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:
