 review all matters affecting the community to make appropriate corrections when necessary and
 to make recommendations to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate actions;
 and
- Baca/Prewitt Chapter, as a part of Honorable Delegate George Tolth's Region, was allocated funds from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Delegate Regional Expenditure plan is to provide services to the Community of Baca/Prewitt Chapter; and
- Baca/Prewitt Chapter, knows that the Fiscal Recovery Funds are specifically intend to respond to the COVID-19 public health emergency, and its negative economic impacts, including assisting our community, and
- Pursuant to CJN-29-22 the Navajo Nation Central Government may award funding to the LGA-Certified Chapters through sub-recipient agreements to implement and manage specific projects, Baca/Prewitt would like to exercise its LGA authority to receive the Navajo Nation Fiscal Recovery Fund and manage the projects: and
- Baca/Prewitt Chapter believes it is in the best interest of the community and its chapter to support and approve the Baca/Prewitt Expenditure Plans for the benefit of its community, especially during the on-going COVID-19 pandemic.
