APPROVING IN SELECTION OF THE OJO ENCINO CHAPTER PRIORITY PROJECT LISTING FOR AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUNDING INCONCLUSION OF OJO ENCINO CHAPTER DELEGATE REGION IN THE AMOUNT OF 1,100,000.00 MILLION.

WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., section 3 (A) the Ojo Encino Chapter is a duly recognized certified chapter of the Navajo Nation Government, as listed at 11N.N. C. part 1, section 10 and:
- 2. Pursuant to 26 N.N. C., Section 1 (8) Ojo Encino Chapter is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community and to make appropriate corrections when necessary and make recommendation to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate actions, and
- 3. The Ojo Encino Chapter has identified four (4) projects for the American Rescue Plan Act funding in the amount of 1.1 million, which as follows; and
 - 1. Ojo Encino Community Waste Water Construct in the amount of \$250,000.00
 - 2. Ojo Encino Chapter Bathroom Addition in the amount of \$421,747.00
 - 3. Ojo Encino Septic Clean Out and Repair Failed Septic Systems \$102,000.00
 - 4. Ojo Encino Chapter Renovation in the amount of \$326,253.00
- 4. The Ojo Encino Chapter requests the Navajo Nation Fiscal Recovery Fund Office, Division of Community Development, and the Department of Justice to consider the four (4) projects For Ojo Encino Community.
- The Ojo Encino Chapter affirms that the Chapter will only use awarded Fiscal Recovery Funds
 (FRF) and implement this FRF Expenditure Plan in compliance with the ARPA, ARPA regulations,
 and with all applicable Federal and Navajo Nation Laws, Regulations and Policies.

1. The Ojo Encino Chapter hereby proposes, supports and approves the requests for funding through the American Rescue Plan Act; and
