Funding will be used to facilitate much needed upgrades to the Hardrock Chapter Senior Center HVAC System and help purchase industrial grade refrigerator & freezer units, located at the Hardrock Chapter Compound in Hardrock, AZ. These upgrades will improve morale of workers and clientele by bring jobs, nutritious foods, socialization and outside social and health services to the people in these post-pandemic times. With many new rules and health related practices, the senior center is essential in bringing information and education to the elder community and this will greatly help mitigate COVID-19 concerns in the future.

The completion of this project will continue daily essential operations such as providing meals for our senior citizens and a place for respite and socialization, especially after 2-3 years of precautions and isolation due to COVID-19. This will also help bring social and basic medical services to our elders and a space to educate about precautions and news as needed regarding elder well-being.



RESOLUTION OF HARD ROCK CHAPTER: HRC 2023/09-03 APPROVING THE SELECTION OF THE HARDROCK CHAPTER SENIOR CENTER UPGRADES PROJECT TO BE INCLUDED FOR HARDROCK CHAPTER DELEGATE REGION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$160,000.

WHEREAS

- 1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 3 (A) the Hard Rock Chapter is a duly recognized certified chapter of the Navajo Nation Government, as listed at 11 N.N.C., part 1, section 10, and
- 2. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 1 (B) Hard Rock Chapter is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community and to make appropriate correction when necessary and make recommendation to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate actions, and
- 3. To support the efforts of the Navajo Nation to mitigate the effects of the COVID-19 Pandemic and its negative economic impacts, the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Fiscal Recovery Funds were allocated to help improve the lives of our community members by helping the most vulnerable and elderly get a hot meal on daily basis, as well as finding a place for respite and socialization, as well as provide a space to receive basic medical services such as vaccinations and obtain Personal Protective Equipment to keep safe and healthy:
- 4. The Hardrock Chapter Administration, Community Members and Chapter Officials recommend the approval of the Hardrock Chapter Senior Center Upgrades Project to be included in the Hardrock Chapter Delegate Region in the amount of \$160,000. The funds will be expended as illustrated in Exhibit A (attached).
- 5. Hardrock Chapter affirms that the Chapter will use the awarded Funds in compliance with the ARPA, the ARPA Regulations, and all other applicable Navajo Nation and Federal laws and regulations.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Hard Rock Chapter hereby approves and implement the Hardrock Chapter Senior Center Upgrades Project to be included in the Hardrock Chapter Delegate Region in the amount of \$160,000.
