- Pursuant to N.N.C., Section 1 (B), the Ts'ah Bii Kin Chapter is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community, make appropriate corrections when necessary, and provide recommendations to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate action(s); and
- The Ts'ah Bii Kin Chapter reaffirming resolution TBK 2022-283-009 approxing and supporting the American Rescue Plan Act Fund Regional Expenditure Plan Projects for the Ts'ah Bii Kin Chapter to include House Wiring and Electrification in the amount of \$425.446.34: Home Renovation Projects in the amount of \$713.145.00: and the Warehouse Project in the amount of \$1.267.200.00: Affirming that the TS ah Bii Kin Chapter will only use awarded funds in compliance with the ARAP, the ARPA Regulations, and all other applicable Navajo and Federals Laws and Regulations, and:
