THE NAATSISAAN (NAVAJO MOUNTAIN) CHAPTER HEREBY REQUEST OF RESOURCE AND DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE OF THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL TO FUND THE NAATSISAAN CHAPTER PROPOSED POWERLINE EXTENSION, SOLAR ENERGY ASSESSMENTS AND COST ESTIMATE FOR ARCHEALOGICAL SURVEYS AND ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT FROM AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FOR THE THIRTY-ONE (31) HOMEOWNERS LISTEDS AND FURTHERMORE REQUEST OF THE NAVAJO TRIBAL AUTHORITY (NTUA) TO COMMENCE PREPARATION FOR RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR THE AREA OF NAATSIS'AAN (NAVAJO MOUNTAIN), UTAH AND ARIZONA

WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 3 (A), the Naatsis'Aan (Navajo Mountain)
 Chapter is duly recognized non-governance certified Chapter of the Navajo Nation
 Government, as listed at I I N. N. N., Part I, Section 10; and
- 2. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 1 (B), the Naatsis'Aan (Navajo Mountain) Chapter is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community and to make decisions and recommendations to the Navajo Nation and other agencies for appropriate actions; and
- 3. Naatsis'Aan (Navajo Mountain) Chapter has identified a Power line and Solar Energy as a Chapter priority and to provide service for thirty-one homes who are in need of electrical services within services within the Navajo Mountain, Utah and Arizona;
- 4. The Naatsis'Aan (Navajo Mountain) Chapter has been working to complete Power line and Solar Energy for the rest of Navajo Mountain's for the benefit of our community and future generations; and

- 5. Naatsis'Aan (Navajo Mountain) Chapter is a recognized Chapter of the Navajo Nation Government vested with authority and responsibilities consider and take actions on matters of local concern that are in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of its chapter members and residents; and
- 6. Naatsis'Aan (Navajo Mountain) Chapter has homeowners name list and GPS locations for this new project:
- 7. Some of the names provided had been served years ago who are experiencing financial hardship to pump out black and gray from individual sewage systems along with needed repairs or replacement for cistern systems, and
- 8. Naatsis'Aan (Navajo Mountain) Chapter is working to make sure all homes are not left out, as a result, the Chapter provided is name list for consideration for direct assistance through American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Funds.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The Naatsis'Aan (Navajo Mountain) Chapter hereby request of Resource and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council to fund the Naatsis'Aan (Navajo Mountain) Chapter proposed Power line and Solar Energy, from American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) for the thirty-one (31) homeowners listed.
- 2. Furthermore, requested of the Navajo Tribal Utility Authority (NTUA) to commence preparation for Right-of-Way Assessment and to determine the cost estimate for archaeological survey and environmental assessment for the proposed Power line and Solar Energy to serve thirty-one (31) homes within Naatsis'Aan (Navajo Mountain), Utah and Arizona.
