SUPPORTING AND APPROVING THE APPENDIX A, THE NAVAJO NATION FISCAL RECOVERY FUNDS REQUEST FORM AND EXPENDITURE PLAN FOR OLIATO CHAPTER CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW WAREHOUSE PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,267,200.00 FOR STORAGE OF PPE'S, WATER, WOOD, COAL, FOOD AND HEAVY EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Oljato Chapter is a duly recognize certified under Title 26 NNC, Section B-1, of the Navajo Nation and is vested with the authority and responsibility to plan and implement projects in the interest of the community; and
- 2. The Oljato Chapter has the responsibility and authority to promote, protect, and preserve the interest and general welfare including the safety of its community people, program, property; and
- 3. The Oljato Chapter is requesting funding from the ARPA funding in the amount of \$1,267,200,00 for a 3 Bay 50' X 80"; 4000 square feet warehouse to store PPE's, Water, Food, Coal and Heavy Equipment; and
- 4. The project purpose is to serve Utah and Arizona residents of Oljato Chapter to address health and safety issues to improve the standard of living to all residents, with an emphasis on the mitigating the spread of COVID-19 of the community.

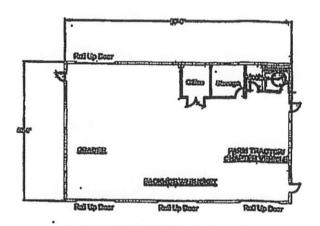
