#### RESOLUTION OF NASCHITTI COMMUNITY GOVERNANCE

NASCHITTI COMMUNITY GOVERNANCE APPROVES AND ACCEPTS THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA) – NAVAJO NATION FISCAL RECOVERY FUND EXPENDITURE PLANS FOR THE SELECTION OF THE BATHROOM ADDITIONS PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$551,747.70 FOR THE NEEDS OF THE NASCHITTI COMMUNITY

#### WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to N.N.C. Title 26, Chapter 1, Section 3(A), Section 1(B)(1) and Section 1(B)(2) under the Local Government Act, Naschitti Community Governance is a certified local governmental entity of the Navajo Nation and is vested with the authority to address local concerns and the authority to make decisions with responsibility and accountability; and
- 2. To support the efforts of the Navajo Nation to mitigate the effects of the COVID-19 Pandemic, the ARPA Fiscal Recovery Funds were allocated to develop the basic infrastructure to improve lives of people who have lived without water, electricity and "basic services to support their daily activities, health, and welfare"; and
- 3. The Navajo Nation Council approved CJN-29-22, in response to the COVID-19 Pandemic in the best interest of the people; "An Action Relating to the Naabiki'iyati' Committee and Navajo Nation Council; Allocating \$1,070,298,867 of Navajo Nation Fiscal Recovery Funds; Approving the Navajo Nation Fiscal Recovery Fund Expenditure Plans for: Chapter Assistance; Public Safety Emergency Communications; E911; Rural Addressing Projects; Cyber Security; Public Health Projects; Economic Development Projects; Hardship Assistance; Water and Wastewater Projects; Broadband Projects; Home Electricity Connection and Electricity Capacity Projects; Housing Projects and Manufactured Housing Facilities; Bathroom Addition Projects; Construction Contingency Funding; and Reduced Administrative Funding; and
- The Naschitti Community Governance accepts the allocations for the ARPA-NNFRF allocation in the amount of \$551,747.70 for the Naschitti Community; and
- The Naschitti Community Governance Administration will be the point of contact on all administrative matters.
- Naschitti Community Governance (Chapter) affirms that the Chapter will only use awarded
  Fiscal Recovery Funds and implement this FRF Expenditure Plan in compliance with the
  ARPA, ARPA Regulations, and with all applicable federal and Navajo Nation laws,
  regulations, and policies.
