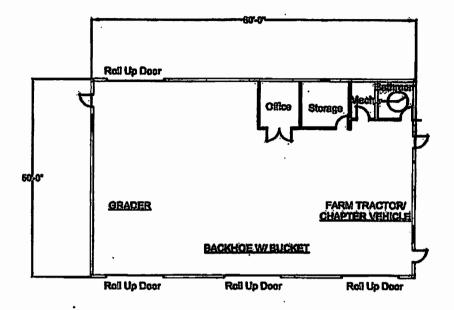

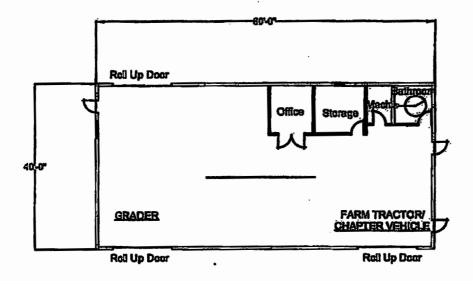

Approving the Appendix, A, the Navajo Nation Fiscal Recovery Funds Request Form & Expenditure Plan for Dennehotso Chapter's Construction of a New Warehouse Projects for the Storage of PPE's, Water, Wood, Coal, and Food; and to Mitigate the COVID-19 Pandemic.

WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C Section 3 (A), the Dennehotso Chapter continues as a certified chapter of the Navajo Nation Government, as listed at 11 N.N.C, part 1, section 10; AND
- Pursuant to 26 N.N.C Section 1 (B), the Dennehotso Chapter is vested with the authority
 to review all matters affecting the community and to make appropriate correction(s)
 when necessary and make recommendation(s) to the Navajo Nation and other local
 agencies for appropriate action(s); AND
- The Dennehotso Chapter is requesting funding from the ARPA funding pool in the amount of \$1,267,200.00; for a 3 Bay 50' by 80' 4,000 square feet warehouse; the funds will be used for construction of a new warehouse for the secure storage of PPE's, water, wood, coal, food and other valuable assets; and to mitigate the COVID-19 Pandemic; AND
- 4. The Dennehotso Chapter warehouse is beyond repair, it is dilapidated condition, and the roof is leaking; AND
- 5. The Dennehotso Chapter is requesting funding in the amount of 1,267,200.00 for a 3 Bay 50' by 80', 4,000 square feet warehouse, and the warehouse will be built on Dennehotso Chapter's property; AND
- The Dennehotso Chapter will advertise through the Navajo Times newspaper for an Invitation for Bid to potential vendors operating on and off the Navajo Nation, announcing a Competitive Sealed Bidding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Dennehotso Chapter hereby approves the Appendix A, the Navajo Nation Fiscal Recovery Funds Request Form & Expenditure Plan for Dennehotso Chapter's

- Construction of a new warehouse project, for the requested funding amount of \$1.2 Million for a 3 Bay 50' by 80', 4,000 square feet warehouse' attached as Appendix "A"
- 2. The Dennehotso Chapter Administration will be responsible for implementation of the warehouse project, and to maintain the operation and its maintenance cost.
- 3. The Dennehotso Chapter Administration shall initiate the construction of the New Warehouse Project in Fiscal Year 2023, and the estimated date of completion of the Project will be before December 31, 2026.
