

RESOLUTION OF DENNEHOTSO CHAPTER

Approving the Appendix, A, the Navajo Nation Fiscal Recovery Funds Request Form & Expenditure Plan for Dennehotso Chapter's Construction of Bathroom Additions for Chapter Membership Who Do Not have Running Water or Septic System, to Mitigate the COVID-19 Pandemic.

WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C Section 3 (A), the Dennehotso Chapter continues as a certified chapter of the Navajo Nation Government, as listed at 11 N.N.C, part 1, section 10; AND
- Pursuant to 26 N.N.C Section 1 (B), the Dennehotso Chapter is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community and to make appropriate correction(s) when necessary and make recommendation(s) to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate action(s); AND
- The Dennehotso Chapter is requesting funding from the ARPA funding pool in the amount of \$384,000; for the Construction of bathroom additions, waterline extensions and installation of scattered cistern tank systems; to mitigate the COVID-19 Pandemic; AND
- 4. Some of Dennehotso Chapter's memberships who live in remote locations do not have bathrooms additions with adequate indoor plumbing, potable running water, waterline extension and cistern tank system; they are at risk to COVID-19 Pandemic; AND
- The Dennehotso Chapter will work in corporation with Kayenta IHS Service Unit-Office of Environmental Health (OEH) for the construction of bathroom additions and installation of waterline extension and scatter cistern tank system; AND
- The Dennehotso Chapter will advertise through the Navajo Times newspaper for an Invitation for Bid to potential vendors operating on and off the Navajo Nation, announcing a Competitive Sealed Bidding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

 The Dennehotso Chapter hereby approves the Appendix A, the Navajo Nation Fiscal Recovery Funds Request Form & Expenditure Plan for Dennehotso Chapter's Construction of Bathroom Additions for Chapter Membership Who Do Not Have Running Water or Septic System, to Mitigate the COVID-19 Pandemic; attached as Appendix "A".

- 2. The Dennehotso Chapter Administration and HIS-OEH will be responsible for implementation of the bathroom additions project.
- 3. The Dennehotso Chapter IHS Service Unit-Office of Environmental Health has determined the Bathroom Additions Project feasible, and they have identified the project as funded on their SCS Report.
- 4. The Dennehotso Chapter Administration shall initiate the Construction of the Bathroom Additions in Fiscal Year 2023, and the estimate date of completion of the Project will be before December 31, 2026
