






AMENDING THE RESOLUTION # CCH-09-2022C, TO PURCHASE MODULAR HOMES USING ARPA FUND FOR THE SEVEN UNHOUSED RESIDENTS

WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 3 (A) the Chilchinbeto Chapter is a duly recognized certified chapter of the Navajo Nation Government, as listed at 11 N.N.C., part 1, section 10, and
- 2. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 1 (B) Chilchinbeto Chapter is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community and to make appropriate correction when necessary and make recommendation to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate actions, and
- 3. The Chilchinbeto Chapter has identified seven people in the community that direly needs a safe and healthy shelter to live in. Some of their homes have dilapidated homes with serious asbestos, roof caved in, walls cracked and foundation has displaced and ready to fall. They absolutely have an unlivable structure, and
- 4. Chilchinbeto Chapter has an eligible housing assistance project that meets the ARPA-FSF guidelines. Below is a list of people that have been selected.
