APPROVING TO USE THE ARPA-FSF FUNDS ON COMMUNITY SEPTIC SERVICES. Resolution # CCH-10-07-2022C

WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to Title 26 N.N.C., Chilchinbeto Chapter is a Certified Chapter of the Navajo Nation and is delegated the authority and responsibility to promote projects which benefits the local community; and
- Pursuant to 2 N.N.C., Section 4028 (a), the Chilchinbeto Chapter is vested with the authority to review all
 matters affecting the community and make appropriate recommendations to the Navajo Nation, Federal,
 State, and local agencies for appropriate actions; and
- The Chilchinbeto Chapter has an allocation of \$2.9 million dollar to provide chapter services, make capital purchases, or use as part of the recovery program according to the ARPA, and Utility Aid is one of the eligible projects listed in the guide lines; and
- 4. The Chilchinbeto Chapter is planning to hire a contractor to service all the septic tanks for community registered residents who apply for services between November 1st, 2022 to January 31, 2023. The contractor will have (12) months to complete the services.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

 The Chilchinbeto Chapter hereby approve to forward a request to the American Rescue Plan Act Fiscal Recovery Fund Committee; Community Development Project Management; and the Navajo Nation Budget and Finance Committee for an ARPA fund to pay up to \$125,345.00.
