APPROVING THE REQUEST TO UTILIZE THE DELEGATE HENIO REGIONAL EXPENDITURE PLAN FUNDS TO PLAN, DESIGN, AND CONSTRUCT ALAMO CHAPTER WATER SYSTEM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,048,166.00

WHERE AS:

- Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 3 (A) the Alamo Chapter is a duly recognized certified chapter of the Navajo Nation Government, as listed at N.N.C., part 1, section 10, and
- Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 1 (B) Alamo Chapter is vested with the authority to review all
 matters affecting the community and to make appropriate correction when necessary and make
 recommendation to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate action, and
- The Alamo Navajo Chapter, as part of Honorable Delegate Jamie Henio, was allocated funds from the American Rescue Pal Act (ARPA) Delegate Regional Expenditure Plan to provide services to the Community of Alamo Navajo Chapter, and
- The Alamo Navajo Chapter is submitting a funding proposal in the amount of \$3,048,166.00 additional funds will be required to outfit, treat, and connect the newly constructed well to the existing water system; and
- The Alamo Navajo Chapter shall work together to upgrade the water system, this project will support the community to fight the public health threat posed by the ongoing public health emergency by providing the community with access to reliable water for drinking, washing, and fire safety.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- Alamo Navajo Chapter approves and respectfully submits the funding proposal packet and budget in the amount of \$3,048,166.00 to better service out community of Alamo.
- Alamo Navajo Chapter will work together to plan, design and construct and addition to the Water System Upgrade.
