#### WHERAS:

- 1. The Bodaway/Gap Chapter is certified and recognized by the Transportation and Community Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council, by way of Resolution TCDCD-44-10; and
- 2. Pursuant to Title 26 of the Navajo Nation Code §1 (B) (1), the Navajo Nation Council delegates the Bodaway/Gap Chapter governmental authority with respect to local matters consistent with Navajo Law, including custom and tradition; and
