SUPPORT AND APPROVE THE REQUEST OF THE DELEGATE REGIONAL EXPENDITURE PLAN TO FUND TO PLAN, DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE WAREHOUSE IN AMOUNT OF \$426,493.50

WHEREAS:

- 1. The K'ai'Bii'Tó Chapter is certified by N.N.C. pursuant to 2 N.N.C. Section 4001 and 4028 (a) as established Navajo Nation Chapter to serve as Local Governing entity to promote matters affecting its Community and pursuant to N.N.C. Section 4002 and it may enact Local Community Ordinance on issues involving its local Constituency, subject to an approval of appropriate N.N.C. oversight Committees; and
- 2. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C. 1001 (A), the K'ai'Bii'Tó Chapter is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community and to make the appropriate corrections when necessary and to make recommendations to the Navajo Nation, State, Federal and other local agencies for appropriate actions; and
- 3. The K'ai'Bii'Tó Chapter strives for the betterment of its people by providing and assisting them with opportunity for improvement in the areas of livelihood, health, safety, and education; and
- 4. American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 was approved by U.S. Congress on March 05, 2021 and was signed by the U.S. President Joe Biden on March 11, 2021; and
- 5. The Navajo Nation was awarded \$1.9 Billion for funding for individuals, businesses, and state, local and tribal governments; and
- 6. The funding provides additional relief to address the continued negative impact of COVID-10; and
- 7. The K'ai'Bii'Tó Chapter requests the renovation of the existing Warehouse, in which is in dire need of a repair and would be ready for emergencies in the future to store the Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), and to house the heavy equipment; and
- 8. The K'ai'Bii'Tó Chapter requests the renovation to include 6 inches of Concrete Slab Flooring, one (1) Roll up Garage Door, Corrugated Metal Sheeting, and one (1) Standard Security Entrance Door; and
- 9. The K'ai'Bii'Tó Chapter request the proposed upgrade for the warehouse by adding Infrastructure (waterline, sewer line, and powerline), street lights as Security, and Fencing around the perimeter; and
- 10. The K'ai'Bii'Tó Chapter is attaching the map of the location of the existing warehouse.

- 4. The K'ai'Bii'Tó Chapter recognizes that multi-generational and multi-family that have returned to the Navajo Nation due to the COVID19 Pandemic, in dire need of a storage facility of the PPE, dry goods, necessities, etc., transporting of heavy equipment, and temporary employees; and
- 5. The K'ai'Bii'Tó Chapter has selected projects within the community to combat COVID19:
 - a. Warehouse
 - b. Housing
 - c. Meeting Room Renovation
 - d. Temporary Employment
 - e. Purchase of a Vehicle
 - f. Purchase of a Heavy-Duty Goose-Neck Trailer
- 6. The K'ai'Bii'Tó Chapter will budget for the project listed; and
