The Upper Fruitland Community Cemetery will provide a site where many loved ones will be interred especially those affected from the COVID-19 Pandemic. The Upper Fruitland community and Navajo Nation were severly impacted from the pandemic having saturated their Rose Garden cemetery to capacity and requiring the construction of a new site. The land has already been withdrawn, surveyed, required archaelogical studies completed and is basically shovel ready for continuing development. The project will address the deficiencies connected to the outbreak of the COVID-19 on the Navajo Nation. The governmental services will facilitate sustainable economic and social growth document attached

(b) Explain how the Program or Project will benefit the Navajo Nation, Navajo communities, or the Navajo People:

Most rural communities on the Navajo Nation lack access to governmental services and COVID-19 impeded these operations. The Navajo Nation experienced substantially grater rates of COVID-19 mortality compared to other racial and ethnic groups. Those living on the Navajo Nation are vulnerable to the virus, due to the high rates of poverty, over crowded liing conditions and limited access to high-quality medical facilities. This project will assist and directly benefit the Navajo people.
