WHERAS:

- 1. Chichiltah Chapter Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 3 (A) the Chichiltah Chapter is a duly recognized certified chapter of the Navajo Nation Governance, as listed at N.N.C., part 1, section 10; and
- 2. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 1 (B), Chichiltah Chapter is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community and to make appropriate correction when necessary and make recommendation to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate actions; and
- 3. Chichiltah Chapter community request for electrical house wiring to improve the quality of life; and
- 4. The Chichiltah increased in home dwellings, wood frame and mobile homes which need house wiring and meter service pole installation; and
- 5. The Chichiltah Chapter has prioritized house wiring and powerline service connections which will improve the quality of living conditions for our community members.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

 Chichiltah Chapter is requesting funding from the Navajo Nation ARPA/FRF and Navajo Nation Council Legislation CJN-29-22 in the amount of \$100,000 for powerline connections for the Chichiltah community.
