### RESOLUTION OF THE TSE' LICHII CHAPTER RRC-016-2023-008

Approving and Supporting the Resolution #CJN-29-22 of the Navajo Nation 24<sup>th</sup> Navajo Nation Council To Fund Chapter and Regional Projects in the amount of \$8.8 million dollars Which Would Allow Red Rock Chapter Implement Various Waterline Projects and Requesting Funds from Delegate Honorable Speaker Seth Damon's Shortfall Expenditure Plan in the Amount of \$460,000.00 of the American Rescue Plan Act.

#### WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section I, (B, (1), (2) and Section 103, the Tse'Lichii Chapter is recognized as a local government entity and delegated certain authorities and responsibilities with respect to local matters consistent with Navajo Nation law; and
- 2. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C., Section 4028(a), the Tse'Lichii Chapter has the authority to review all matters affecting the community and make appropriate recommendations to the Navajo Nation, County and State government agencies; and
- 3. Because of the Covid-19 Pandemic, the United States government passed Legislation ARPA (American Rescue Plan Act) to allow the Navajo Nation is to support the COVID-19 public health and economic response by addressing COVID 19 and its support for public health; and
- 4. The passage of ARPA (American Rescue Plan is also to pay premium pay to eligible workers performing essential services and to make necessary investments in water, sewer and broadband infrastructure; and
- 5. The 14<sup>th</sup> Navajo Nation Council passed and approved Resolution CJN-29-22 which approved the Navajo Nation Fiscal Recovery Fund Expenditure Plans for chapter and regional projects and rural addressing, water and wastewater projects, broadband projects, home electricity connection, and bathroom additions projects; and
- 6. The Navajo Nation received \$211, 256,148 as a total allocation which is to be distributed equally between the 24 chapters; the total allocation to each chapter is \$8,892,240.
- 7. The Tse'Lichii Chapter has been working on building a new Senior Center and the design phase has been completed and the construction of the new building is its next step; however, the chapter lacks construction funds in the amount of \$460,000 to start construction.

#### NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Tse'Lichii Chapter approves and supports Resolution #CJN-29-22 of the 24<sup>th</sup> Navajo Nation Council legislation which would allow the Senior Center to be completed using the ARPA funds. The Tse'Lichii Chapter is requesting \$4,000,000 from the ARPA funds to initiate construction of the the Senior Center Building.
