#### RESOLUTION OF THE MANUELITO NAVAJO CHAPTER

Supporting and approving the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) expenditure plan for the septic sewage tank cleaning project in the amount of \$100,000 for Manuelito Chapter community members.

#### WHEREAS:

- N.N.C. Title 26 delegates Navajo Nation Chapters certain authority to review all matters
  affecting the community based on sound decision which are consistent with the Navajo
  Nation codes, laws, custom, and tradition; and
- Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 1 (B) Manuelito Navajo Chapter is vested with the authority on all matters affecting the community, make appropriate actions when necessary and make recommendations to the Navajo Nation government and other federal/state/local agencies; and
- 3. The Manuelito Navajo Chapter has determined that septic sewage tank cleaning and disposal of sewage is a necessary need for community members when it comes to proper personal hygiene, especially when it comes to COVID and any other viruses that may limit travel and attending self quarantine when ill; and
- 4. The Manuelito Navajo Chapter has determined that the number of homes living below or around the poverty threshold are immense in the community and financially struggling families need assistance to keep their septic sewage tanks properly cleaned; and
- 5. The Manuelito Navajo Chapter will contract out to a vendor or vendors to complete the septic sewage tank cleanouts project.

### **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:**

Manuelito Chapter supports and approves the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) expenditure plan for its septic sewage tank cleanout project for homes in the amount of \$100,000 for Manuelito community members.
