Modification of project budget

Mr. Mitchell,

The Chilchinbeto Chapter is modifying a project budget with the timeline. The chapter has redirected the ir Regional FRF Allocation which was set at \$500,000.0 for Ground Prep. It is appropriate now to inject these funds to new projects.

This happened because the construction was planned to be done by the local workforce, but the policy requires certified personnel and it must be done by a contractor.

The following project need to be modified are:
