Amending and Approving Resolution KY22-125-10. Approving the Appendix A, Navajo Nation Fiscal Recovery Funds Request Form & Expenditure Plan for Kayenta Chapter to Purchase a Backhoe for Emergency Burial Assistance for COVID-19 related deaths, to unload PPEs, Food, Water, Wood off Semi and Cargo Trucks; and to Mitigate the COVID-19 Pandemic.

WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C, § 3(A), the Kayenta Chapter continues as a certified chapter of the Navajo Nation Government, as listed at 11 N.N.C, part 1, § 10; AND
- 2. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., § 1(B), the Kayenta Chapter is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community and to make appropriate correction(s) when necessary and to make recommendation(s) to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate action(s); AND
- 3. The Kayenta Chapter is requesting funding for its membership, from the ARPA funding pool in the amount of \$206,055.38 to purchase a Backhoe, it will be used for emergency burial assistance for COVID-19 related deaths of tribal members, to unload PPEs, food, water, wood off of semi and cargo trucks; and to mitigate the COVID-19 Pandemic; AND
- 4. The Kayenta Chapter will not use the Backhoe to grade road for residents; AND
- 5. The Kayenta Chapter will advertised through the Navajo Times newspaper for an Invitation for Bid to potential vendors operating on and off the Navajo Nation, announcing a Competitive Sealed Bidding.
- Chapter affirms that the Chapter KAYENTA will only use awarded Funds in compliance with ARPA, the ARPA Regulations, and all other applicable Navajo Nations and Federal Laws and Regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The Kayenta Chapter hereby approves the Appendix A, the Navajo Nation Fiscal Recovery Funds Request Form & Expenditure Plan for Kayenta Chapter to Purchase a Backhoe for \$206,055.38 to be used for Emergency Burial Assistance for COVID-19 related deaths, to unload PPEs, Food, Water, Wood off Semi and Cargo Trucks; and to Mitigate the COVID-19 Pandemic.
- 2. The Kayenta Chapter will be responsible for the operations and the maintenance cost of the Backhoe.
- 3. The Kayenta Chapter Administration shall initiate the Procurement of the Backhoe in Fiscal Year 2023, and the estimated date of completion of the Project will be before December 31, 2026.
