- Pursuant to 2 N.N.C., Section 4028 (a), the Chilchinbeto Chapter is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community and make appropriate recommendations to the Navajo Nation, Federal, State, and local agencies for appropriate actions; and
- 3. Chilchinbeto Chapter has been allocated for ARPA-FRF funding appropriated to the Navajo Nation Delegate Region for various eligible projects, and
- 4. Chilchinbeto Chapter has (5) five senior members that have been trying to complete their house with very limited resources and it is imperative that they receive the assistance needed to shelter them safely from all pandemic.
