The purchase of the septic service truck with a 300-gallon tank will enable health and safety for the people in the Chilchinbeto Chapter. The community does not have a septic service nearby and most of them do not come to Chilchinbeto. We have over 220 septic tanks in the community, but most of them are currently not in use for lack of services, lack of funds, or lack of decent roads. The purchase of the septic service truck will enable the chapter to provide a healthy place to live for the residents. Most residents use outside toilets, even wheelchair-bound residents on cold winter nights.

(b) Explain how the Program or Project will benefit the Navajo Nation, Navajo communities, or the Navajo People:

The Navajo Nation, the Navajo community, and the Navajo people will once again have the ability to use wastewater from the home and allow the active bacteria to dissolve and consume waste. This provides a clean and healthy living for the people and they do not have to deal with cold weather, or struggle to get to the rest rooms outside their home.

RESOLUTION OF CHILCHINBETO CHAPTER OF THE NAVAJO NATION Resolution # CCH-04-01-2023G

APPROVING TO USE THE \$180,000.00 TO PURCHASE 300 GALLON HEAVY DUTY SEPTIC SERVICE TRUCK.

WHEREAS:

1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 3 (A) the Chilchinbeto Chapter is a duly recognized certified chapter of the Navajo Nation Government, as listed at 11 N.N.C., part 1, section 10, and

2. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 1 (B) Chilchinbeto Chapter is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community and to make appropriate correction when necessary and make recommendation to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate actions, and

3. The Chilchinbeto Chapter is roughly more than 30 miles away from the nearest septic service and the cost for families to be serviced is higher than any other metropolitan area. Most families cannot afford to pay for the service on regular schedule. More than 200 homes in Chilchinbeto uses septic tank and most of them are full and the homeowner can not afford to get it service, and

4. Chilchinbeto Chapter does not have enough lagoons and the lack of infrastructure is causing the septic tank to backup. Most users are living on fixed income and numerous are in wheelchairs. It will be easier for the chapter to provide septic.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. Chilchinbeto Chapter hereby approve to use the ARPA Delegate Region funds of \$180,000.00 toward the purchase of a heavy duty septic service truck with a 300 gallon tank.
- Chilchinbeto Chapter affirms that the Chapter will only use awarded funds in compliance with the ARPA, the ARPA Regulations, and all other applicable Navajo Nation and Federal laws and regulations.
