- 3. Churchrock Chapter is invested to review all matters affecting the community to make favorable decisions in the best interest over local matter, such as cultural preservations, economic development, safety, and welcome of chapter membership; and
- 4. The Churchrock Chapter, as part of Honorable Delegate Steven Arviso's Region, was allocated funds from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Delegate Regional Expenditure plan to provide services to the Community of Churchrock Chapter; and
- 5. The Churchrock Chapter shall work together with community members to plan, design and renovate existing bathroom additions to meet ADA compliance; and
- 6. The Churchrock Chapter affirms that the Chapter will only use awarded Fiscal Recovery Funds and implement this FRF Expenditure Plan in compliance with the ARPA, ARPA Regulations, and with all applicable federal and Navajo Nation laws, regulations, and policies.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The Churchrock Chapter membership hereby approves the amendment to include additional language and respectfully submits the funding proposal packet and budget in the amount of \$467,056 to plan, design, and renovate existing bathroom additions.
- 2. The bathroom additions shall be provided with fixtures as needed with ADA compliance approval.
- Replacement of bathroom floors will be provided as needed.
