- Churchrock Chapter is invested to review all matters affecting the community to make favorable decisions in the best interest over local matter, such as cultural preservations, economic development, safety, and welcome of chapter membership; and
- 4. The Churchrock Chapter, as part of Honorable Delegate Steven Arviso's Region, was allocated funds from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Delegate Regional Expenditure plan to provide services to the Community of Churchrock Chapter; and
- Churchrock Chapter shall work together to identify all community homes, gather pertinent information such as lat./long. coord., home type, color, etc., and made available to emergency responders; and
- The Churchrock Chapter affirms that the Chapter will only use awarded Fiscal Recovery Funds
  and implement this FRF Expenditure Plan in compliance with the ARPA, ARPA Regulations,
  and with all applicable federal and Navajo Nation laws, regulations, and policies.
