APPROVING THE PROCUREMENT OF A HOUSE ELECTRICAL WIRING PROJECT FOR SEVEN (7) FORMER BENNETT FREEZE AREA (FBFA) RESIDENTS UNDER THE NAVAJO NATION FISCAL RECOVERY FUND EXPENDITURE PLAN

WHEREAS:

- Pursuant to 26 NNC, Section 3(A). the Tolani Lake Chapter is a duly recognized chapter of the Navajo Nation Government, as listed at 11 NNC, Part 1, Section 10; and
- 2. Pursuant to 26 NNC, Section 1(B), the Tolani Lake Chapter is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community to make recommendations to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriations; and
- 3. Pursuant to CAP -34-98, the Navajo Nation Council adopted the Navajo Nation Local Governance Act (GA); and
- 4. The Tolani Lake Chapter officials demonstrates their ongoing dedication to support the Division of Community Development office assisting with ARPA projects and performs a variety of administrative functions including, drafting of budget guidelines and justifications, monitoring expenditures and approvals, problem solving, monitoring, evaluates progress, preparing reports, correspondence, and presentations; and
- 5. Pursuant to Resolution CJN-29-22, The Navajo Nation Council allocated \$1,760,468 for five (5) chapters within the district 5 and District 3 in response to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic; and
- 6. The Tolani Lake Chapter has identified (7) eligible families in the Former Bennett Freeze area (FBFA) who are qualified for electric house wiring who has waited years to receive electric power; and
- The electrical house wiring project will be purchased according to the Navajo Nation procurement policies and
 procedures will be followed, vendor/contractor selection and project management will be implemented to the project is
 completed; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The Tolani Lake Chapter hereby approves the procurement of a house electrical wiring project for seven (7) former bennett freeze area (FBFA) residents under the Navajo Nation fiscal recovery fund expenditures plan.
