
This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committee. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each Council Delegate to review the proposed resolution in detail.

21 SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- 22 A. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C.
23 §102(A).
24 B. The Naabik'iyáti' Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation Council
25 with the delegated responsibility to hear proposed resolution(s) that require final
26 action by the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. § 164(A)(9).
27 C. Navajo Nation Council Resolution No. CJN-29-22, incorporated herein by reference,
28 mandates that Navajo Nation Fiscal Recovery Fund ("NNFRF") Delegate Region
29 Project Plans be approved by Navajo Nation Council resolution and signed into law
30

1 by the President of the Navajo Nation pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 164 (A) and 2 N.N.C.
2 §§ 1005 (C) (10), (11), and (12).

3 D. Navajo Nation Council Resolution No. CD-61-22, herein by reference, mandates that
4 amendments to the Navajo Nation Fiscal Recovery Fund Delegate Region Project Plan
5 for Honorable Vince R. James' Delegate Region (Chapter: Jeddito, Cornfields,
6 Ganado, Kinlichee, Steamboat) be approved by a Navajo Nation Council resolution
7 and signed into law by the President of the Navajo Nation pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 164
8 (A)(17), and 2 N.N.C. §§ 1005 (C) (10), (11), and (12).

10 **SECTION TWO. FINDINGS**

11 A. Navajo Nation Council Resolution No. CJN-29-22, AN ACTION RELATING TO
12 THE NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEE AND NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL;
13 ALLOCATING \$1,070,298,867 OF NAVAJO NATION FISCAL RECOVERY
14 FUNDS; APPROVING THE NAVAJO NATION FISCAL RECOVERY FUND
15 EXPENDITURE PLANS FOR: CHAPTER AND REGIONAL PROJECTS; PUBLIC
16 SAFETY EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS, E911, AND RURAL
17 ADDRESSING PROJECTS; CYBER SECURITY; PUBLIC HEALTH PROJECTS;
18 HARDSHIP ASSISTANCE; WATER AND WASTEWATER PROJECTS;
19 BROADBAND PROJECTS; HOME ELECTRICITY CONNECTION AND
20 ELECTRIC CAPACITY PROJECTS; HOUSING PROJECTS AND
21 MANUFACTURED HOUSING FACILITIES; BATHROOM ADDITION
22 PROJECTS; CONSTRUCTION CONTINGENCY FUNDING; AND REDUCED
23 ADMINISTRATIVE FUNDING, was signed into law by the President of the Navajo
24 Nation on July 15, 2022.

25 B. CJN-29-22, Section Three, states, in part and among other things, that

- 26 1. The Navajo Nation hereby approves total funding for the NNFRF Chapter
27 and Chapter Projects Expenditure Plan from the Navajo Nation Fiscal
28 Recovery Fund in the total amount of two hundred eleven million two
29 hundred fifty-six thousand one hundred forty-eight dollars (\$211,256,148)
30 to be divided equally between the twenty-four (24) Delegate Regions in the

1 amount of eight million eight hundred two thousand three hundred forty
2 dollars (\$8,802,340) per Delegate Region . . . and allocated through Delegate
3 Region Project Plans approved by Navajo Nation Council resolution and
4 signed into law by the President of the Navajo Nation *See* CJN-29-22,
5 Section Three (B).

6 2. The Delegate Region Project Plan funding will be allocated to the Navajo
7 Nation Central Government, specifically the Division of Community
8 Development or other appropriate Navajo Nation Division or Department,
9 to implement the projects rather than directly to the Chapters. *See* CJN-29-
10 22, Section Three (D).

11 3. The Navajo Nation Central Government, specifically the Division of
12 Community Development or other appropriate Navajo Nation Division or
13 Department, shall manage and administer funds and Delegate Region
14 Project Plans on behalf of Non-LGA-Certified Chapters. The Navajo Nation
15 Central Government may award funding to LGA-Certified Chapters through
16 sub-recipient agreements to implement and manage specific projects, but
17 shall maintain Administrative Oversight over such funding and Delegate
18 Region Project Plans. *See* CJN-29-22, Section Three (E).

19 4. Each Navajo Nation Council delegate shall select Fiscal Recovery Fund
20 eligible projects within their Delegate Region to be funded by the NNFRF
21 Chapter and Regional Projects Expenditure Plan through a Delegate Region
22 Projects Plan. The total cost of projects selected by each Delegate shall not
23 exceed their Delegate Region distribution of eight million eight hundred two
24 thousand three hundred forty dollars (\$8,802,340). *See* CJN-29-22, Section
25 Three (F).

26 5. Each Delegate Region Project shall identify its Administrative Oversight
27 entity and its Oversight Committee(s) and be subject CJY-41-21's NNDOJ
28 initial eligibility determination. *See* CJN-29-22, Section Three (L)(5) and
29 (L)(6).

30

1 C. The Navajo Nation Council Resolution No. CD-61-22, AN ACTION RELATING TO
2 THE NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEE AND NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL;
3 APPROVING THE NAVAJO NATION FISCAL RECOVERY FUND DELEGATE
4 REGION PROJECT PLAN FOR HONORABLE VINCE R. JAMES' DELEGATE
5 REGION (CHAPTERS: JEDDITO, CORNFIELDS, GANADO, KINLICHEE,
6 STEAMBOAT), was signed into law by the President of the Navajo Nation on January
7 6, 2023.

8 D. CD-61-22, Section Four, states that:

9 1. Amendments to this legislation or to the Delegate Region Project Plan approved
10 herein shall only be adopted by resolution of the Navajo Nation Council and
11 approval of the President of the Navajo Nation pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 164 (A)(17)
12 and 2 N.N.C. §§ 1005 (C) (10), (11), and (12).

13 E. All additional projects listed in the Hon. Vince R. James' Delegate Region Projects
14 Plan, attached as **Exhibit A**, have been deemed Fiscal Recovery Fund eligible by
15 NNDOJ. In addition, Hon. Vince R. James' Delegate Region Projects Plan does *not*
16 exceed the amount of \$8,802,340, as set forth in CJN-29-22, Section Three (F).

17 F. The Navajo Nation Council hereby finds that it is in the best interest of the Navajo
18 Nation and the Hon. Vince R. James' Delegate Region Chapters and communities to
19 approve and adopt the additional projects as part of the Navajo Nation Fiscal Recovery
20 Fund Delegate Region Project Plan for Hon. Vince R. James' Delegate Region
21 (Chapters: Jeddito, Cornfields, Ganado, Kinlichee, Steamboat) as set forth in **Exhibit**
22 **A**.

23
24 **SECTION FOUR. AMENDING CD-61-22, THE NAVAJO NATION FISCAL**
25 **RECOVERY FUND DELEGATE REGION PROJECT PLAN FOR HONORABLE**
26 **VINCE R. JAMES' DELEGATE REGION (CHAPTERS: JEDDITO,**
27 **CORNFIELDS, GANADO, KINLICHEE, STEAMBOAT), TO INCLUDE**
28 **ADDITIONAL PROJECTS FOR THIS DELEGATE REGION**

29 A. The Navajo Nation hereby approves the additional projects as part of the Navajo Nation
30 Fiscal Recovery Fund Delegate Region Project Plan for Hon. Vince R. James' Delegate

1 Region (Chapters: Jeddito, Cornfields, Ganado, Kinlichee, Steamboat) set forth in
2 **Exhibit A.**

3 B. The Delegate Region Project Plan approved herein shall comply with all applicable
4 provisions of CJY-41-21, CJN-29-22, and BFS-31-21.

5 C. Any inconsistencies between this legislation, the Delegate Region Project Plan, and the
6 individual project appendix, shall be resolved in favor of the project appendix reviewed
7 by Department of Justice during their eligibility determination(s).

8
9 **SECTION FIVE. AMENDMENTS**

10 Amendments to this legislation or to the Delegate Region Project Plan approved herein
11 shall only be adopted by resolution of the Navajo Nation Council and approval of the
12 President of the Navajo Nation pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 164 (A)(17) and 2 N.N.C. §§ 1005
13 (C) (10), (11), and (12).

14
15 **SECTION SIX. EFFECTIVE DATE**

16 This legislation shall be effective upon its approval pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 221(B), 2 N.N.C.
17 § 164 (A)(17), and 2 N.N.C. §§ 1005 (C) (10), (11), and (12).

18
19 **SECTION SEVEN. SAVING CLAUSE**

20 If any provision of this legislation is determined invalid by the Navajo Nation Supreme Court,
21 or by a Navajo Nation District Court without appeal to the Navajo Nation Supreme Court,
22 those provisions of this legislation not determined invalid shall remain the law of the Navajo
23 Nation.

RESOLUTION OF THE KINDAHLICHII CHAPTER
RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE NAVAJO NATION DIVISION OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT,
OFFICE OF THE NAVAJO PRESIDENT, VICE PRESIDENT, OFFICE OF THE SPEAKER AND THE
NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL FOR ALLOCATION OF AMERICAN RELIEF PROTECTION ACT FUNDS
FOR INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT AND TO ADDRESS OTHER KINDAHLICHII CHAPTERS
COMMUNITY UNMET/UNFUNDED NEEDS (EXHIBIT B)

WHEREAS.

1. Kindahlichii Chapter is government certified pursuant to 26 NNC, Section 102(B) which permits the Kindahlichii Chapter to exercise local governance authorities contained within the 26 NNC, Section 103; and
2. The Kindahlichii Chapter pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 1(B) is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community and to make appropriate decisions when necessary and make recommendations to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate actions; and
3. The Navajo Nation continues to experience the on going COVID-19 epidemic and has not fully recovered. It is for the reason for recovery efforts from the pandemic the United State President authorized American Relief Funds; and
4. The American Relief Protection Act funds are recommended to be used for Infrastructure Development for which KinDahLichii Chapter identified powerline and water line extensions to continue. Bathroom additions to home which do not have electricity or running water.
5. The KinDahLichii Chapter identified some priority projects for which it is seeking funds;
1. Head start Building construction cost, 2. Paving the Chapter Parking Lot, 3. Purchase warehouse.
6. The Head Start was built in 1963 and has been cited for deficiencies as not meeting the environmental health safety standards requiring constant or continuous repairs.
7. The Kin Dah Lichii Chapter community has many projects and there should be kept as part of the equal distribution at \$1.7 million as earmarked for Kin Dah Lichee Chapter.
8. The American Relief Protection Act should be directed to benefit the Kin Dah Lichee Chapter community members.

NOW THEREFOR BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

Kin Dah Lichii requests the Navajo Nation Division of Community Development, Office of the President and Vice President, Office of the Speaker and the Navajo Nation Council to allocate

RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE NAVAJO NATION DIVISION OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT,
OFFICE OF THE NAVAJO PRESIDENT, VICE PRESIDENT, OFFICE OF THE SPEAKER AND THE
NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL FOR ALLOCATION OF AMERICAN RELIEF PROTECTION ACT FUNDS
FOR INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT AND TO ADDRESS OTHER KINDAHLICHII CHAPTERS
COMMUNITY UNMET/UNFUNDED NEEDS (EXHIBIT B)

WHEREAS.

1. Kindahlichii Chapter is government certified pursuant to 26 NNC, Section 102(B) which permits the Kindahlichii Chapter to exercise local governance authorities contained within the 26 NNC, Section 103; and
2. The Kindahlichii Chapter pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 1(B) is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community and to make appropriate decisions when necessary and make recommendations to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate actions; and
3. The Navajo Nation continues to experience the on going COVID-19 epidemic and has not fully recovered. It is for the reason for recovery efforts from the pandemic the United State President authorized American Relief Funds; and
4. The American Relief Protection Act funds are recommended to be used for Infrastructure Development for which KinDahLichii Chapter identified powerline and water line extensions to continue. Bathroom additions to home which do not have electricity or running water.
5. The KinDahLichii Chapter identified some priority projects for which it is seeking funds;
1. Head start Building construction cost, 2. Paving the Chapter Parking Lot, 3. Purchase warehouse.
6. The Head Start was built in 1963 and has been cited for deficiencies as not meeting the environmental health safety standards requiring constant or continuous repairs.
7. The Kin Dah Lichii Chapter community has many projects and there should be kept as part of the equal distribution at \$1.7 million as earmarked for Kin Dah Lichee Chapter.
8. The American Relief Protection Act should be directed to benefit the Kin Dah Lichee Chapter community members.

NOW THEREFOR BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

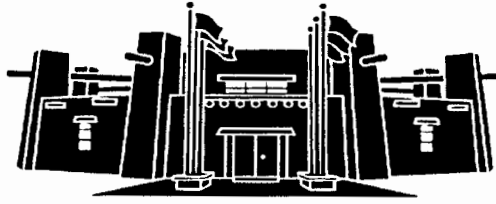




