

RESOLUTION OF THE COPPERMINE CHAPTER OF THE NAVAJO NATION

APPROVING THE PROCUREMENT OF SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AS A CHAPTER PROJECT UNDER THE NAVAJO NATION FISCAL RECOVERY FUND EXPENDITURE PLAN.

WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant 26 N.N.C., Section 3, and 11 N.N.C., Section 10, The Coppermine Chapter is a duly recognized Chapter of the Navajo Nation Government; and
- 2. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Chapter 1: Navajo Nation Chapter, Section 1, (B) (1) & (20), The Navajo Nation Council delegated chapter governmental authority with respect to local matters consistent with Navajo Law, including custom and tradition and allow chapters to make decisions to govern with responsibility and accountability to community membership; and
- 3. The Coppermine Chapter is empowered to advocate on behalf of its constituents for the improvements of their health, education, safety, and general welfare; and
- 4. Pursuant to Resolution CJN-29-22, The Navajo Nation Council allocated \$1,760,468.00 for five chapters within District #01 and #03 in response to impact of the Covid-19 pandemic; and
- In 1995, the Navajo Nation and Coconino County developed a Joint Powers Agreement regarding matching funds to pay for solid waste for seven (7) chapters in the Western Navajo Agency including Coppermine Chapter; and
- 6. In August, 2012, The Coppermine Chapter was removed from the Joint Powers Agreement due to lack of matching funds from the Navajo Nation Sanitation to dispose of waste; and
- 7. The Coppermine Chapter began operating its own solid waste on September 1, 2012 and began collecting fees and hired a custodian to help manage the solid waste for the community of Coppermine; and
- 8. Last August 2022 the contract for the community's solid waste contract expired on account of the Coppermine Chapter's unavailable funds for the increased cost of solid waste transfer with Republic Services; and
- 9. The Coppermine Chapter is in great need for a solid waste disposal management for the community's sanitation and well-being.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Coppermine Chapter hereby approves the procurement of a chapter approving the purchase of PPE supplies as a chapter project under the Navajo Nation Fiscal Recovery Fund expenditure plan.

- 2. Pursuant to N.N.C., Section 1., (B) (1) & (2), The Navajo Nation Council delegated to the chapter governmental authority with respect to local matters consistent with Navajo Law, including custom and tradition and allows the chapter to make decisions to govern with responsibility and accountability to community membership; and
- 3. The Coppermine Chapter, a recognized certified local government of the Navajo Nation, vested with the power and authority to advocate on behalf of its constituents for the improvement of health, education, safety and general welfare; and
- Pursuant to resolutions RCD-216-99 and RDCJN-33-15 and subsequent appropriate policies, the Coppermine Chapter complies with procedures for land withdrawal for burial plot and cemeteries; and
- 5. The proposed burial site already is the final resting place for 2 individuals and properly fenced which will not affect any grazing use, farm land, or homesite leases areas; and
- 6. A legal survey and description, with a map, hereby is attached as Exhibit A; and
- The proposed package is hereby forwarded for proper approval.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Coppermine Chapter hereby supports and recognizes the Land Withdrawal for the Coppermine Community Cemetery. The designated site is proposed in compliance with section 7 (B) of the land withdrawal regulations of resolution # RDCJN-38-15.


