Requesting Approval from the Navajo Nation and the Division of Community Development to Allocate \$1,710,363.70 from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) for the Construction of Cost of Materials and Labor for Bathroom Addition Projects for the Many Farms Chapter

WHEREAS:

1. Pursuant to CMY-23-79, the Many Farms Chapter is a certified Chapter of the Navajo Nation vested with authority and responsibilities to provide and enact on all matters affecting the community; and
2. Pursuant to CAP-34-98, the Navajo Nation Council approved the Navajo Nation Local Governance Act (LGA) that allows Many Farms Chapter to make decisions over local matters; and
3. The Federal Public Health have measured in May 2020, the Navajo Nation had the highest per capita COVID-19 infection rate in the country, there were more than 10,300 cases and 555 confirmed deaths from a population of roughly 175,000; and
4. The COVID-19 pandemic has raised attention to our people the lack of access to clean water may have exacerbated the spread of coronavirus and had complicated efforts to curtail it; and
5. Although the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act funding for COVID-19 relief efforts has helped address immediate public health needs, the Many Farms Chapter community continues to require sustained efforts by our leaders to ensure all households have access to clean water and wastewater for our community; and
6. The Office of Environmental Health (O.E.H) has provided the attached information for (42) community members who are in need of Bathroom Additions (attached are the list of names, maps and project numbers); and
7. The Many Farms Chapter requests an additional \$75,000.00 for funding to support Public Employment Projects (PEP) to construct these Bathroom Additions; and
8. The Many Farms Chapter warrants the dire need of increased funding for the chronically underfunded infrastructure water projects within the Many Farms community.


