- 4) Thoreau Chapter membership is desirous of enhancing the living standards and providing healthy environment for residents living in the community of Thoreau Chapter, Navajo Nation, McKinley County, New Mexico; and
- 5) Thoreau Chapter is submitting an Expenditure Plan in the amount of \$100,000.00 to purchase wood stoves and pellet stoves to provide source of heat for community membership.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1) Thoreau Chapter membership hereby approves the request to utilize the Delegate Regional Expenditure Plan Funds for American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Project – Purchase Wood Stoves and Pellet Stoves for community membership in the amount of \$100,000.00.
