Let this serve as our notice of the following changes to Tsé Chi'zhí's approved and proposed Projects:

- 1- The Tsé Chi'zhí Home Weatherization & Rehab will be renamed to the Tsé Chi'zhí Home Roofing Weatherization Project, K2115454.
- 2- Tsé Chi'zhí Community Culvert Installation K2l15455 \$195,000 will be decreased to \$105,118 and partially reallocated to the Tsé Chi'zhí Home Roofing Weatherization, K2l15454 in the amount of \$89,882.
- 3- Tsé Chi'zhí Spiritual Wellness Center K2l15456 \$99,194 will be deleted and the whole amount to be allocated to the Tsé Chi'zhí Home Roofing Weatherization Project, K2l15454.
- 4- The proposed Tsé Chi'zhí Community Water Delivery K2ll5__ will not be included in a legislation BUT the total amount of \$62,924 will be allocated to the Tsé Chi'zhí Home Roofing Weatherization.
- 7- The Tsé Chi'zhí Home Roofing Weatherization project will have a total of \$460,000 to use for a contractor that will complete as many shingled roofing weatherization as possible.

Tsé Chi'zhí Chapter will be submitting the revised Home Roofing Weatherization Project shortly. Please assist my Chapter in getting these processed through the system.

ROUGH ROCK CHAPTER

HOME WEATHERIZATION PROJECT

GENERAL SUMMARY

The Rough Rock Chapter is a recipient of Fiscal Recovery Funds through Legislation CJN-29-22 and has an approved Expenditure Plan (HK0629) for Housing Weatherization and Rehab in the amount of \$208,000.

LAM Corporation conducted assessments of eighteen (18) homes as of March 26, 2024. LAM corresponded with the Chapter regarding concerns projected costs that were developed for the home renovations based on the initial assessments and amount of work being requested by the applicants for each home. LAM advised the Chapter that the scope for the renovation efforts needs to be reduced based on the Chapter's expenditure plan budget.

A progress meeting was held on Tuesday, March 26, 2024, where it was decided by the Chapter to reduce the scope of work to a single construction discipline for roofing projects.

PROJECT ASSUMPTIONS

- 18 homes have been assessed as of March 26, 2024
- Out of the remaining applicants that have <u>not</u> yet been assessed, two names were recommended to move forward when subsequent assessments are scheduled since their applications were for roofing.
- In addition, the Chapter has submitted an additional seven (7) applicants to have assessed for roofing.
