REQUESTING FUNDING FROM NAVAJO NATION ARPA/FRF AND NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL LEGISLATION CJN-29-22 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$900,000 FOR A SUSTAINABLE WAREHOUSE FOR CHICHILTAH CHAPTER COMMUNITY

WHERAS:

- 1. Chichiltah Chapter Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 3 (A) the Chichiltah Chapter is a duly recognized certified chapter of the Navajo Nation Governance, as listed at N.N.C., part 1, section 10; and
- 2. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 1 (B), Chichiltah Chapter is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community and to make appropriate correction when necessary and make recommendation to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate actions; and
- Chichiltah Chapter community request a sustainable warehouse for the purposes of emergency evacuations, emergency materials and supplies storage, space for emergency providers to mitigate emergency pandemic and all other forms of disease and virus to protect community members; and
- 4. The Chichiltah Chapter requests the warehouse be constructed of sustainable materials to include non-toxic concrete floor with bathroom-shower, office space, sufficient utility source, unloading dock and entrance to accommodate heavy equipment which will be assessable during an emergency; and
- 5. The Chichiltah Chapter is located 60-miles from the nearest fire station and emergency service providers, and this will be a central location during emergency.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- Chichiltah Chapter is requesting funding from the Navajo Nation ARPA/FRF and Navajo Nation Council Legislation CJN-29-22 in the amount of \$900,000 to construct a sustainable warehouse for the Chichlah community.
- 2. Chichiltah Chapter has obtained \$500,000 match funds from the State of New Mexico to accomplish the scope of work.
