REQUESTING FUNDING FROM NAVAJO NATION ARPA/FRF AND NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL
LEGISLATION CJN-29-22 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,000 FOR RURAL ADDRESSING TO BE ALLOCATED TO
MCKINLEY COUNTY TO UPDATE OUR 911 RURAL ADDRESSING SYSTEM IN CHICHILTAH COMMUNITY

WHERAS:

- Chichiltah Chapter Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 3 (A) the Chichiltah Chapter is a duly recognized certified chapter of the Navajo Nation Governance, as listed at N.N.C., part 1, section 10; and
- 2. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 1 (B), Chichiltah Chapter is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community and to make appropriate correction when necessary and make recommendation to the Navajo Nation and other local agencies for appropriate actions; and
- Chichiltah Chapter in 1989, was funded by the McKinley County Commission, established our first community rural addressing system in collaboration with private landowners, NM State land lessees, Indian Allotment, Bureau of Land Management, Navajo Trust Land Permittees to have an emergency rural address; and
- 4. Chichiltah Chapter throughout the years have not maintained the system due to lack of fund and manpower as our community is the largest Chapter land base south of Gallup, New Mexico; and
- Chichiltah Chapter increased new home dwellings, and the need to delete homes which are no longer occupied and to update the mapping and shapefiles with McKinley County Rural Addressing to address our critical need for 911 Rural Addressing; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

Chichiltah Chapter requests from Navajo Nation ARPA/FRF and the Navajo Nation Council Legislation CIN-29-22 in the amount of \$200,000 for Rural Addressing to be Allocated to McKinley County to update our 911 Rural Addressing system in Chichiltah community.
