- Pursuant to Chapter 1, Section 1(B)(2) of the same "Act", Tsayatoh Chapter is vested with the authority to make decisions over local matters and to govern with responsibility and accountability the local citizen; and
- 4. Tsayatoh community members approves and accepts the resolution the fiscal year '23, Seth Damon Delegate Regional Expenditure Plans in the amount of \$400,000.00 for plans and design and construction for Convenience center for collection and recycling.
- 5. Joint Regional Solid Waste with Manuelito, Rock Springs, and Red Rock Chapters.

# NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- The Tsayatoh Chapter hereby approves and accepts the resolution the fiscal year '23, Seth Damon Delegate Regional Expenditure Plans in the amount of \$400,000.00 for plans and design and construction for Convenience center for collection and recycling.
