#### **RESOLUTION OF THE MANUELITO NAVAJO CHAPTER**

#### Supporting and approving the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) expenditure plan for the planning, design, construction of a fixed wireless broadband telecommunication buildout in the amount of \$2,035,000 for Manuelito Chapter community.

#### WHEREAS:

- 1. N.N.C. Title 26 delegates Navajo Nation Chapters certain authority to review all matters affecting the community based on sound decision which are consistent with the Navajo Nation codes, laws, custom, and tradition; and
- 2. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C., Section 1 (B) Manuelito Navajo Chapter is vested with the authority on all matters affecting the community, make appropriate actions when necessary and make recommendations to the Navajo Nation government and other federal/state/local agencies; and
- 3. The Manuelito Navajo Chapter has worked with Sacred Wind Communication, LLC, on previous projects and did work with the Manuelito Community Land Use Planning Committee (CLUPC) to identify dead to weak zones located throughout Manuelito resulting in a map identifying the areas (attached) with a price quote; and
- 4. The Manuelito Navajo Chapter would like to continue that working relationship with Sacred Wind Communications when it comes to contracting out the buildout of the broadband and telecommunication construct; and
- 5. The Manuelito Navajo Chapter realizes that fixed wireless broadband service with cellular and home telecommunication is a necessity in the rural areas of the United States especially with the recent COVID related viruses that will help homes receive quick service when it comes to public health, public safety, and education.

#### NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

Manuelito Chapter supports and approves the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) expenditure plan for the planning, design, construction of a fixed wireless broadband telecommunication buildout in the amount of \$2,035,000 for Manuelito community and to work with Sacred Wind Communications, LLC, on the construction and build-out of the proposed ARPA project.
