- 1. Pursuant to Title 26 N.N.C., Chilchinbeto Chapter is a Certified Chapter of the Navajo Nation and is delegated the authority and responsibility to promote projects which benefits the local community; and
- Pursuant to 2 N.N.C., Section 4028 (a), the Chilchinbeto Chapter is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community and make appropriate recommendations to the Navajo Nation, Federal, State, and local agencies for appropriate actions; and
- The Chilchinbeto Chapter has an allocation of \$2.9 million dollar to provide chapter services, make capital purchases, or use as part of the recovery program according to the ARPA, and Utility Aid is one of the eligible projects listed in the guide lines; and
- The Chilchinbeto Chapter is planning to hire a contractor to service all the septic tanks for community registered residents who apply for services between November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022 to January 31, 2023. The contractor will have (12) months to complete the services.


