III. Comments by CGS:

This fransmittal documents 3rd budget entered in FMIS on \$8.8 mil ARPA funds allocated to CD Norman Begay's Region. Y-T-D budget in FMIS for CD Normal Begay totals \$10,482,279. Information on Section I. of Transmittal above reflects \$8,802,340 ARPA funding allocated for distribution to Chapters the respective Council Delegate service aka Region and listing of Chapters. Resolution No. NABIN-43-23 is to increase Delegate Begay region by \$5,982,279 and decrease \$2,000,000 from prior Resolution, however budget was not submitted to decrease amount. Therefore, the budget from prior Resolution No. CAP-12-23 in the amount of \$2,000,000 that has not been submitted to CGS needs to be submitted immediately.

RESOLUTION OF THE NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' STANDING COMMITTEE 25th NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL -- First Year, 2023

AN ACTION RELATING TO THE NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEE; AMENDING CJY-50-23 AND CAP-12-23, THE NAVAJO NATION FISCAL RECOVERY FUND DELEGATE REGION PROJECT PLAN FOR HONORABLE NORMAN M. BEGAY'S DELEGATE REGION (CHAPTERS: ALAMO, RAMAH, TOHAJIILEE), TO REMOVE A PROJECT AND INCLUDE ADDITIONAL PROJECTS FOR THIS DELEGATE REGION

BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- A. The Naabik'íyáti' Committee is established as a standing committee of the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. § 700(A).
- B. Navajo Nation Council Resolution No. CJN-29-22, as amended by CAU-74-23, mandates that Fiscal Recovery Fund ("NNFRF") Delegate Region Project Plans be approved by two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Naabik'íyáti' Committee members in attendance.
- C. Navajo Nation Council Resolution No. CAP-12-23, attached as Exhibit 1 (without project exhibits) included and incorporated herein by reference, mandated that amendments to the Navajo Nation Fiscal Recovery Fund Delegate Region Project Plan for Honorable Norman M. Begay's Delegate Region (Chapters: Alamo, Ramah, Tohajiilee) be approved by a Navajo Nation Council resolution and signed into law by the President of the Navajo Nation pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 164(A)(17), and 2 N.N.C. §§ 1005(C)(10), (11), and (12).
- D. Navajo Nation Council Resolution No. CJY-50-23, included and incorporated herein by reference, mandated that amendments to the Navajo Nation Fiscal Recovery Fund Delegate Region Project Plan for Honorable Norman M. Begay's Delegate Region (Chapters: Alamo, Ramah, Tohajiilee) be approved by a Navajo Nation Council resolution and signed into law by the President of the Navajo Nation pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 164(A)(17), and 2 N.N.C. §§ 1005(C)(10), (11), and (12).
- E. Navajo Nation Council Resolution No. CAU-74-23, which amended CJN-29-22 and CJY-41-21, included and incorporated herein by reference, delegated the Naabik'iyati' Committee as the final approval authority for Delegate Region Project Plans funded through Navajo Nation's Fiscal Recovery Funds.

SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

- Navajo Nation Council Resolution No. CJN-29-22, AN ACTION RELATING TO THE NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEE AND NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; ALLOCATING \$1,070,298,867 OF NAVAJO NATION FISCAL RECOVERY FUNDS; APPROVING THE NAVAJO NATION FISCAL RECOVERY FUND EXPENDITURE PLANS FOR: CHAPTER AND REGIONAL PROJECTS; PUBLIC SAFETY EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS, E911, AND RURAL ADDRESSING PROJECTS; CYBER SECURITY; PUBLIC HEALTH PROJECTS; HARDSHIP ASSISTANCE; WATER AND WASTEWATER PROJECTS: BROADBAND PROJECTS: HOME ELECTRICITY CONNECTION AND ELECTRIC CAPACITY PROJECTS; HOUSING PROJECTS AND MANUFACTURED FACILITIES: BATHROOM ADDITION PROJECTS; CONSTRUCTION CONTINGENCY FUNDING; AND REDUCED ADMINISTRATIVE FUNDING, was signed into law by the President of the Navajo Nation on July 15, 2022.
- B. CJN-29-22, as amended by CAU-74-23, Section Three, now states, in part and among other things, that
 - 1. The Navajo Nation hereby approves total funding for the NNFRF Chapter and Chapter Projects Expenditure Plan from the Navajo Nation Fiscal Recovery Fund in the total amount of two hundred eleven million two hundred fifty-six thousand one hundred forty-eight dollars (\$211,256,148) to be divided equally between the twenty-four (24) Delegate Regions in the amount of eight million eight hundred two thousand three hundred forty dollars (\$8,802,340) per Delegate Region . . and allocated through Delegate Region Project Plans approved by two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Naabik'íyáti' Committee members in attendance . . . See CJN-29-22, as amended by CAU-74-23, Section Three (B).
 - 2. The Delegate Region Project Plan funding will be allocated to the Navajo Nation Central Government, specifically the Division of Community Development or other appropriate Navajo Nation Division or Department, to implement the projects rather than directly to the Chapters. See CJN-29-22, Section Three (D).
 - 3. The Navajo Nation Central Government, specifically the Division of Community Development or other appropriate Navajo Nation Division or Department, shall manage and administer funds and Delegate Region Project Plans on behalf of Non-LGA-Certified Chapters. The Navajo Nation Central Government may award funding to LGA-Certified Chapters through sub-recipient agreements to implement and manage specific projects, but shall maintain

- Administrative Oversight over such funding and Delegate Region Project Plans. See CJN-29-22, Section Three (E).
- 4. Each Navajo Nation Council delegate shall select Fiscal Recovery Fund eligible projects within their Delegate Region to be funded by the NNFRF Chapter and Regional Projects Expenditure Plan through a Delegate Region Projects Plan. The total cost of projects selected by each Delegate shall not exceed their Delegate Region distribution of eight million eight hundred two thousand three hundred forty dollars (\$8,802,340). See CJN-29-22, Section Three (F).
- 5. Each Delegate Region Project shall identify its Administrative Oversight entity and its Oversight Committee(s) and be subject CJY-41-21's NNDOJ initial eligibility determination. See CJN-29-22, Section Three (L)(5) and (L)(6).
- C. The Navajo Nation Council Resolution No. CAP-12-23, AN ACTION RELATING TO THE NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEE AND NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; APPROVING THE NAVAJO NATION FISCAL RECOVERY FUND DELEGATE REGION PROJECT PLAN FOR HONORABLE NORMAN M. BEGAY'S DELEGATE REGION (CHAPTERS: ALAMO, RAMAH, TOHAJIILEE), was signed into law by the President of the Navajo Nation on May 5, 2023. Exhibit 1.
- D. CAP-12-23, Section Four, states that:
 - 1. Amendments to this legislation or to the Delegate Region Project Plan approved herein shall only be adopted by resolution of the Navajo Nation Council and approval of the President of the Navajo Nation pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 164(A)(17) and 2 N.N.C. §§ 1005(C)(10), (11), and (12).
- E. The Navajo Nation Council Resolution No. CJY-50-23, AN ACTION RELATING TO THE NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEE AND NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; AMENDING CAP-12-23, THE NAVAJO NATION FISCAL RECOVERY FUND DELEGATE REGION PROJECT PLAN FOR HONORABLE NORMAN M. BEGAY'S DELEGATE REGION (CHAPTERS: ALAMO, RAMAH, TOHAJIILEE), TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL PROJECTS FOR THIS DELEGATE REGION was signed into law by the President of the Navajo Nation on August 4, 2023.
- F. CJY-50-23, Section Four, states that:
 - 1. Amendments to this legislation or to the Delegate Region Project Plan approved herein shall only be adopted by

resolution of the Navajo Nation Council and approval of the President of the Navajo Nation pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 164(A)(17) and 2 N.N.C. §§ 1005(C)(10), (11), and (12).

- G. The Navajo Nation Council Resolution No. CAU-74-23, AN ACTION RELATING TO THE NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEE AND NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; AMENDING COUNCIL RESOLUTIONS CJY-41-21 AND CJN-29-22; DELEGATING THE NAABIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEE AS THE FINAL APPROVAL AUTHORITY FOR DELEGATE REGION PROJECT PLANS FUNDED THROUGH THE NAVAJO NATION'S FISCAL RECOVERY FUNDS was signed into law by the President of the Navajo Nation on September 6, 2023.
- H. CJN-29-22, as amended by CAU-74-23, Section Three, now states, in part and among other things, that
 - 1. The Navajo Nation hereby approves total funding for the NNFRF Chapter and Chapter Projects Expenditure Plan from the Navajo Nation Fiscal Recovery Fund in the total amount of two hundred eleven million two hundred fifty-six thousand one hundred forty-eight dollars (\$211,256,148) to be divided equally between the twenty-four (24) Delegate Regions in the amount of eight million eight hundred two thousand three hundred forty dollars (\$8,802,340) per Delegate Region . . and allocated through Delegate Region Project Plans approved by two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Naabik'iyati' Committee members in attendance . . . See CJN-29-22, as amended by CAU-74-23, Section Three (B).
- I. The Hon. Norman M. Begay has requested to amend CAP-12-23 to remove the Ramah Navajo Chapter Collection/Transfer Station project (under NNDOJ Review No. HK0348) from the Delegate Region Projects Plan that covers the Alamo, Ramah, Tohajiilee Chapters. The removal of this project will revert \$2,000,000.00 back to Hon. Norman M. Begay's Delegate Region Project Plan's Un-Allocated Amount.
- J. Further, the Hon. Norman M. Begay has requested that additional projects be added to his Delegate Region Projects Plan. The additional projects, which have been deemed Fiscal Recovery Fund eligible by NNDOJ, as well as the removed project, are set forth in Exhibit 2. After the deletion and addition of projects, Hon. Norman M. Begay's Delegate Region Projects Plan does not exceed the amount of \$8,802,340, as set forth in CJN-29-22, Section Three (F).
- K. The Navajo Nation Council hereby finds that it is in the best interest of the Navajo Nation and the Hon. Norman M. Begay's Delegate Region Chapters and communities to approve and adopt

the removal of one-project and the addition of additional projects as part of the Navajo Nation Fiscal Recovery Fund Delegate Region Project Plan for Hon. Norman M. Begay's Delegate Region (Chapters: Alamo, Ramah, Tohajiilee) as set forth in Exhibit 2.

SECTION THREE. AMENDING CJY-50-23 AND CAP-12-23, THE NAVAJO NATION FISCAL RECOVERY FUND DELEGATE REGION PROJECT PLAN FOR HONORABLE NORMAN M. BEGAY'S DELEGATE REGION (CHAPTERS: ALAMO, RAMAH, TOHAJIILEE), TO REMOVE A PROJECT AND INCLUDE ADDITIONAL PROJECTS FOR THIS DELEGATE REGION

- A. The Navajo Nation hereby approves the removal of one-project (the Ramah Navajo Chapter Collection/Transfer Station project under NNDOJ Review No. HK0348) listed in CAP-12-23 for Hon. Norman M. Begay's Delegate Region Projects Plan as stricken in Exhibit 2. The removal of this project from Hon. Norman N. Begay's Delegate Region Projects Plan will revert \$2,000,000.00 back to his Delegate Region's Project Plan's Un-Allocated Amount.
- B. The Navajo Nation hereby approves the additional projects as part of the Navajo Nation Fiscal Recovery Fund Delegate Region Project Plan for Hon. Norman M. Begay's Delegate Region (Chapters: Alamo, Ramah, Tohajiilee) set forth in Exhibit 2.
- C. The Delegate Region Project Plan approved herein shall comply with all applicable provisions of CJY-41-21, CJN-29-22, and BFS-31-21.
- D. Any inconsistencies between this legislation, the Delegate Region Project Plan, and the individual project appendix, shall be resolved in favor of the project appendix reviewed by Department of Justice during their eligibility determination(s).

SECTION FOUR. AMENDMENTS

Amendments to this legislation or to the Delegate Region Project Plan approved herein shall only be adopted and approved by resolution of the Naabik'íyáti' Committee.

SECTION FIVE. EFFECTIVE DATE

This legislation shall be effective upon its approval pursuant to two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Naabik'fyáti' Committee members in attendance.

SECTION SIX. SAVING CLAUSE

If any provision of this legislation is determined invalid by the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, or by a Navajo Nation District Court without appeal to the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, those provisions of this legislation not determined invalid shall remain the law of the Navajo Nation.

Dear Speaker Curley,

I am pleased to sign into law this resolution CAP-12-23 approving the Fiscal Recovery Funds Delegate Regional Project Plan for Honorable Begay's Delegate Region in the amount of \$2,000,000.

My Administration supports the plans of these Chapters who have worked very hard to put together their Regional Plans and is working very closely with the Fiscal Recovery Fund Office to ensure that these funds are put to use. As such, when Chapters are running into roadblocks in expending their Fiscal Recovery Funds and the roadblock is coming from the Executive Branch, I encourage them to reach out to the Office of the President and Vice President and inform my office of the roadblock and we will work to overcome those roadblocks.

I do want to take the moment to express my concern that any amendments to the Regional Plans must be approved by the Council. In addition, the prior Navajo Nation Council has set the expectation that Fiscal Recovery Funds be encumbered by June 30, 2024. This deadline is not far off. As a construction expert, I know that there are unpredictable factors that can prevent even the best of plans from moving forward on the proposed timeline. We should be designing systems that are flexible, accountable, and transparent. We do not currently have that system and I look forward to working with you and the entire Council to improve the Navajo Nation systems, so we are supporting our communities to take advantage of this historic funding.

SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY

- C. Navajo Nation Council Resolution No. CJN-29-22, incorporated herein by reference, mandates that Navajo Nation Fiscal Recovery Fund ("NNFRF") Delegate Region Project Plans be approved by Navajo Nation Council resolution and signed into law by the President of the Navajo Nation pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 164(A) and 2 N.N.C. §§ 1005(C)(10), (11), and (12).

SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

Norman M. Begay's Delegate Region Projects Plan does not exceed the amount of \$8,802,340, as set forth in CJN-29-22, Section Three (F).

D. The Navajo Nation Council hereby finds that it is in the best interest of the Navajo Nation and the Hon. Norman M. Begay's Delegate Region Chapters and communities to approve and adopt the Navajo Nation Fiscal Recovery Fund Delegate Region Project Plan for Hon. Norman M. Begay's Delegate Region (Chapters: Alamo, Ramah, Tohajiilee) as set forth in Exhibit A.

SECTION THREE. APPROVAL OF HON. NORMAN M. BEGAY'S DELEGATE REGION PROJECT PLAN

- A. The Navajo Nation hereby approves the Fiscal Recovery Fund Delegate Region Project Plan for Hon. Norman M. Begay's Delegate Region (Chapters: Alamo, Ramah, Tohajiilee) set forth in Exhibit A.
- B. The Delegate Region Project Plan approved herein shall comply with all applicable provisions of CJY-41-21, CJN-29-22, and BFS-31-21.
- C. Any inconsistencies between this legislation, the Delegate Region Project Plan, and the individual project appendix, shall be resolved in favor of the project appendix reviewed by Department of Justice during their eligibility determination(s).

SECTION FOUR. AMENDMENTS

Amendments to this legislation or to the Delegate Region Project Plan approved herein shall only be adopted by resolution of the Navajo Nation Council and approval of the President of the Navajo Nation pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 164(A)(17) and 2 N.N.C. §§ 1005(C)(10), (11), and (12).

SECTION FIVE. EFFECTIVE DATE

This legislation shall be effective upon its approval pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 221(B), 2 N.N.C. § 164(A)(17), and 2 N.N.C. §§ 1005(C)(10), (11), and (12).

SECTION SIX. SAVING CLAUSE

If any provision of this legislation is determined invalid by the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, or by a Navajo Nation District Court without appeal to the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, those provisions of this legislation not determined invalid shall remain the law of the Navajo Nation.

RESOLUTION OF THE RAMAH NAVAJO CHAPTER

NO. 082207

Approving to Design and Construct a New Water Well and Related Connecting Pipeline to Convey Drinking Water and Provide Fire Protection for the Rocky Ridge Water System, Which Serves the Northern Portion of the Chapter Community; and the Water System is Managed, Operated and Maintained under the Auspices of the Ramah Navajo Utility Authority (RNUA).

Whereas:

- 1. Pursuant to Navajo Tribal Council Resolution CJ-20-55, the Ramah Navajo Chapter is a certified Chapter of the Navajo Nation and the Chapter is uniquely situated as satellite community of the Navajo Nation; and
- 2. Pursuant to 21 Navajo Nation Code §51-60, §§ 1.A; there is established the RNUA within the Ramah Navajo Chapter; and
- By Resolution RNC-82-15, the Ramah Navajo Chapter established the RNUA and its Articles of Establishment and Bylaws to provide utility services to the community; By Resolution RNC-0786223, the Ramah Navajo Chapter established the Plan of Operation for RNUA; and By Resolution ACS-151-86, the Advisory Committee of the Navajo Tribal Council incorporated and adopted the Articles of Establishment and Bylaws and the Plan of Operation for RNUA; and
- 4. By Resolution CAP-34-98, the Navajo Nation Council enacted the Navajo Nation Local Governance Act codified as 26 Navajo Nation Code (N.N.C.), establishing a new title exclusively for political subdivisions of the Navajo Nation to address the governmental function of chapters that improves the governmental structure and provides the opportunity for local chapters to make decisions over local matters; and allowing communities to excel and flourish, enable Navajo leaders to lead toward a prosperous future and improve the strength and sovereignty of the Navajo Nation, including custom and tradition; and
- 5. By Resolution 041614, the Ramah Navajo Chapter adopts and endorses the RNUA's Finance, Property, Personnel, Procurement and Utility Policies and Procedures, with By-Laws, presented as amendments and superseding all prior management and operation policy and procedures, via a public hearing on April 15, 2016 at the Ramah Navajo Chapter House; and
- By Resolution CJN-29-22, the 24th Navajo Nation Council approves Leg. 0086-22, as amended, regarding the NNFRF (ARPA) Expenditure Plan to include Chapter and Regional Projects Expenditure Plan which allow the Council Delegates to select for their regions under the NNFRF Expenditure Plan. Navajo Nation Council approved Resolution CJN-29-22 then was signed into law on July 15, 2022 by the OPVP; and

- The existing shallow well serving the Rocky Ridge Water System is too old and no longer reliable nor cost effective such that it went out of commission recently which required costly repair and constant maintenance and operation by RNUA with limited resources. It is quite obvious a new well will serve the purpose for immediate backup and further meet the demand for abundant, reliable, safe and clean water supply to address the current infamous COVID-19 pandemic and other construction ready infrastructure developments, (i.e.), Judicial District Court Complex, Public Safety Building, and apartments adjacent to Ramah Navajo Detention Center; and
- 8. It is in the best interest of the Ramah Navajo Chapter and community members that supply of water (Life) must meet the ever-increasing demand not only in emergencies but under any normal circumstances in the future and generations to come. Now is most appropriate time with the NN FRF (ARPA) or funds for development of new wells.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Ramah Navajo Chapter hereby approves to design and construct a new water well and related connecting pipeline to convey drinking water and provide fire protection for the Rocky Ridge Water System, which serves the northern portion of the Chapter Community. Attached hereto is NN FRF Request Form (A) and Expenditure Plan (B).
