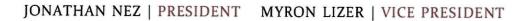

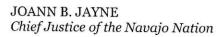

The Administrative Office of the Courts within the Judicial Branch is forwarding to your office the budget for our approved Section Six Funding of \$5,876,685. These funds are authorized by Section 6 of resolution CJY-41-21, which established the Navajo Nation Fiscal Recovery Fund and Expenditure Plan Process for the ARPA funding. This resolution allowed the Judicial Branch, to apply for and use the defunded NN CARES Act amounts.

Our application was reviewed by the Navajo Nation Department of Justice, and approved by Navajo Nation President Jonathan Nez on October 5, 2021. The final budget has been signed Chief Justice Jayne.

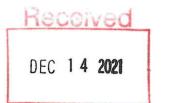

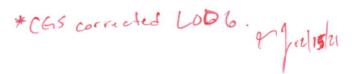
