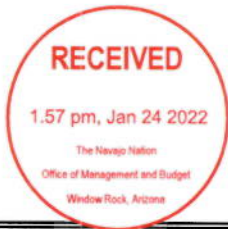



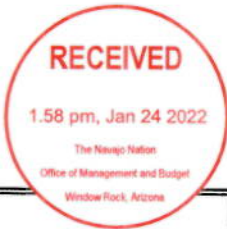

	This project consists of replacing or upgrading crucial components within wastewater collection and conveyance systems throughout the Navajo Nation. It is critical that wastewater is properly collected and conveyed to facilities for treatment. NTUA's wastewater collection system includes numerous lift stations located throughout the Navajo Nation. A lift station moves wastewater from a lower elevation to higher elevation and allows the sewer water to flow into a lagoon or other treatment plant. This project will rehabilitate and upgrade 9 lift stations in Arizona and New Mexico. The ability to collect and convey wastewater for treatment directly address one of the major sanitation needs that is connected to the high outbreak of COVID-19 on the Navajo Nation.
